Our Access Initiative

On March 23, 2006, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) released the "Commission Staff Final Report on Transmission Access" which states that "...Wisconsin ratepayers could benefit from expanded interstate transmission investment, particularly from investment in targeted smaller scale projects" (p. 1). The **Paddock-Rockdale 345-kV** transmission project is a "targeted smaller scale project" which the Access study showed would provide significant ratepayer benefits. As a result, ATC plans to develop a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) application for Paddock-Rockdale. This application will include extensive additional analyses to further examine the merits, risks and impacts of the project under a wide variety of scenarios and sensitivities to ensure that the project is robust under a broad range of potential futures. Preparation for filing the CPCN will include significant additional regional cooperation and planning and public input.
